

ORDINANCE NO. 96-1

SPEED RESTRICTIONS ON COUNTY ROADS

Be it ordained, by the Treasure County Commissioners that: a person operating or driving a Motor Vehicle on any County Road, for which the Treasure County Commissioners have jurisdiction over, shall not drive at a speed in excess of the following limits:

- (a) 45 miles per hour on roads which are primarily gravel or scorio
- (b) 55 miles per hour on roads which are oiled or otherwise paved.

Nothing in this Ordinance restricts the application of other Montana Speed Restrictions Laws.

Violation of this Ordinance shall be punishable by fine not to exceed \$100.00.
